
I've enclosed several documents. It is important you take the time to read them and supply the missing information on the front and the back. All must be returned on the first day! On the front of the **Medical Statement**, if you must put a YES for any item you will be required to visit a physician to get approval to take this course. On the back there is a section for the physician to fill out. If you are in good health and have not said YES to the any questions on the front, you do not need to see a doctor, but you should write the following on the **Remarks** line: **I am in good health and feel I am able to take this course in SCUBA diving.**" Then sign your name.

On the **PADI Liability Release and...** form, please read each of the paragraphs and then initial each on the line before that paragraph. Additionally, where you see the lines for Student Name, fill in your complete name. Sign and date the form at the bottom. If you are under 18 years of age, please have your parents sign and date it also.

Also enclosed is a sheet titled, "**NAUI WAIVER AND RELEASE AGREEMENT**". Please fill in the blank lines: **Top-print your name;** ... city of **New Paltz;** ...County of **Ulster;** ... in the State of **New York;** ... to begin on (enter the date the course begins). **Do NOT sign it until you are at DEEP-SIX.** But, if you are under 18, have your parents sign it at the bottom before the class.

In case of rain we will still hold the course. The pool is heated and you will be wearing partial wet suits for buoyancy as well as warmth. For the four days of SCUBA experience your thoughts will be given top priority! The job at hand is to have you acquire a new sport with good feelings and a strong desire to continue to dive. Incidentally, the course will concentrate on diving in this area as well as in tropical waters.

I am looking forward to working with you. Hopefully you will be able to keep your excitement under control.
